INTRODUCTION

The Maharishi Markandeshwar Trust, formerly the Maharishi Markandeshwar Education Trust, was established in November 1993 in Ambala, Haryana, by the renowned visionary, educationist, and entrepreneur Dr. Tarsem Kumar Garg. Over the course of just twenty-nine years, the Trust has developed numerous higher education and research institutions and advanced its mission quickly. A Deemed to be University at Mullana-Ambala, another state private University in Solan, Himachal Pradesh, MM International Schools at Sadopur, Rambha, and Mullana, and MM School of Nursing and Midwifery at Mullana are among the other institutions created by the Trust in addition to MMU Sadopur. The Trust has proud privileges of establishing the first private engineering institution, first private medical college, and first private Deemed to be University in Haryana and first private medical college in Himachal Pradesh. All of the MM educational institutions have been operating with the approval of the relevant authorities and regulatory bodies.

Through dedicated and resolute efforts of the distinguished Trust members, the educational institutions under the Trust have stayed ahead of the curve in the ever-evolving and dynamic education sector. By offering job oriented state-of-the-art education in various fields, these institutions ensure that the students develop a holistic perspective of their surroundings and become worthy citizens of a global society.

Established in accordance with the provisions of the Haryana Private Universities Act, 2006, **Maharishi Markandeshwar University, Sadopur, Ambala** is governed by Haryana Govt. Act No 29 of 2010. In accordance with Section 22 of the UGC Act, 1956, the University was approved by the UGC to award degrees. The University started out with the following vision and mission:

VISION: To prepare students with an integrated and technology oriented education for a better career and to be worthy citizens of a global society.

MISSION: To develop better than the best professionals for the economic development of the country.

The University campus, which is situated on a 42-acre plot of land in the Ambala suburbs along the Ambala-Chandigarh national highway, is known for its lush green surroundings. The campus is also well connected with the rest of the country by road, rail and air.

The University began offering UG and PG courses in a variety of subjects including engineering and technology, architecture, sciences, management and agriculture in 2010. However, the courses were not well-received by students and had gradually been fizzled out. The University started Institutions of health sciences w.e.f.2023-24.

MAHARISHI MARKANDESHWAR COLLEGE OF MEDICAL SCIENCES & RESEARCH

On the advice of the local expert committee, the MM Trust has made the decision to build a new Medical College and other Health Sciences Institutions on the MMU Sadopur campus, started in the academic year 2023–2024.

As the country needs to increase its doctor-population ratio from 0.5 per 1000 people to 1 per 1000 people by the end of 2027 so as to meet Universal Health Coverage (UHC) requirements. Therefore, by establishing a new Medical College, MM Trust hopes to address the physician deficit in relation to population.

In 2020, the **330 bedded MM Super Specialties Hospital** having total Premise Area of **138050 Sq.m** was founded in MMU campus at Sadopur, Ambala. The bed strength of the hospital has since then increased to **606 beds** as of now. The hospital is surrounded by lush green fields in a suburban area. The hospital's main goal is to offer patients of high-quality care at a reasonable low cost. Most super specialties and all broad specialties are represented in the hospital's facilities. It provides services to the surrounding areas of Punjab, Himachal Pradesh, Uttar Pradesh, and Uttarakhand in addition to Haryana. The Gynaecology department of the MM Super Specialties Hospital has been providing all facilities for free deliveries for child birth. MM INSTITUTE OF NURSING & RESEARCH

In order to cater to the growing demand for nursing professionals in the country, the MM Trust established the MM Institute of Nursing & Research (MMINR) at MMU Sadopur campus, commencing academic activities from 2023-24. Nursing as a profession and a discipline utilizes knowledge derived from arts, sciences (physical, biological and behavioral), humanities and human experience. Nursing science incorporates clinical competence, critical thinking, communication, teaching learning, professionalism, and caring and cultural competency. Nurses collaborate with other health disciplines to solve individual and community health problems. Nursing facilitates evidence-based practice, compassionate caring among its practitioners in response to emerging issues in healthcare and new discoveries and technologies in profession. Nursing practice requires personal commitment to professional development and life-long learning. The faculty has the responsibility to be role models and create learning environment that facilitates cultivation of critical thinking, curiosity, creativity and inquiry driven self- directed learning and attitude of life-long learning in students. Learners and educators interact in a process whereby students gain competencies required to function within their scope of practice. The program prepares nurses and midwives for generalist nursing including midwifery practice, knowledge acquisition related to wellness, health promotion, illness, disease management and care of the dying is core to nursing practice. Mastery of competencies is the main focus. Students are provided with opportunities to learn a whole range of skills in addition to acquiring knowledge related to nursing practice (nursing and midwifery). This is achieved through learning in skill lab/simulated lab and clinical environment. Simulation will be integrated throughout the curriculum wherever feasible to enable them to develop competencies before entry into real field of practice.

The institute presently offers:

- B.Sc. Nursing (4 Years) – Comprehensive undergraduate program focusing on professional nursing competencies.
- GNM (3 Years) – Diploma program in General Nursing & Midwifery with emphasis on clinical and community health practices.

The MMINR is committed to prepare competent, compassionate, and skilled nursing professionals who contribute to improving individual and community health through evidence-based practice, education, and research. MMINR is continuously working for upliftment of society by adopting the following ways:

- By providing quality nursing education that integrates clinical competence, critical thinking, communication, and professionalism.

- By promoting caring and cultural competency in the practice of nursing.

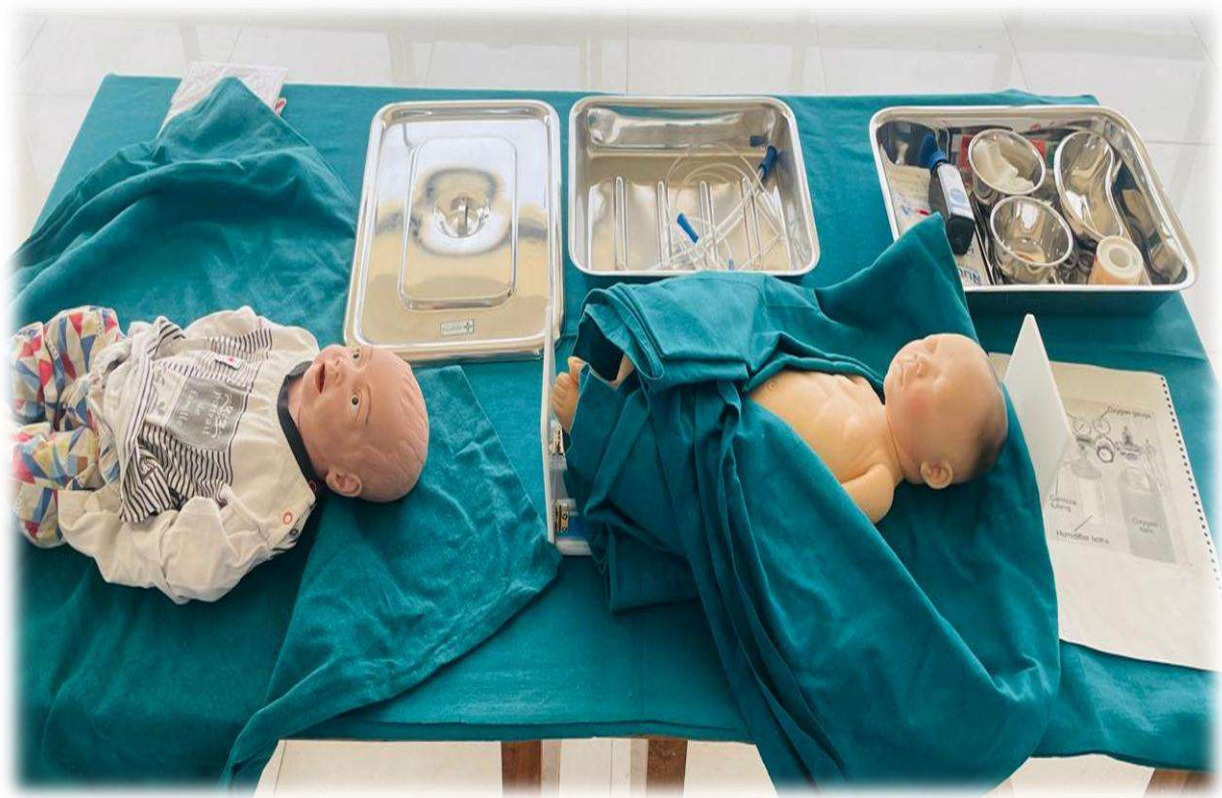

Maharishi Markandeshwar College of Physiotherapy & Rehabilitation (MMCP&R) was established in 2024 by MMU Trust with the aim to extend access to quality physiotherapy education and healthcare services to a wider community.

Academic Program

MMCP&R commenced its first academic program in the session 2024–25 as Bachelor of Physiotherapy (BPT), a four and half year full-time degree program, comprising four years of academic study followed by a six-month compulsory rotatory internship. The course is affiliated with MM University, Sadopur-Ambala, and is associated with the 606-bedded MM Super-Specialty Hospital.

Role of Physiotherapists

According to the National Commission for Allied and Healthcare Professions (NCAHP) Act, 2021, a physiotherapist is a healthcare professional providing treatment and advice related to movement and functional issues using physical modalities. At MMCP&R, students are trained not only in acute care but also in all phases of rehabilitation, including community reintegration. Physiotherapists cater to patients across all age groups, from neonates to the elderly. Physiotherapist is one of the important members of the Healthcare Team, dealing with the restoration, functional independence and quality of life of the patients. Physiotherapists cater to almost all the age groups from neonates to elderly population. The role of physiotherapy is not only limited to the acute care but in all the phases of rehabilitation, including community re-integration.

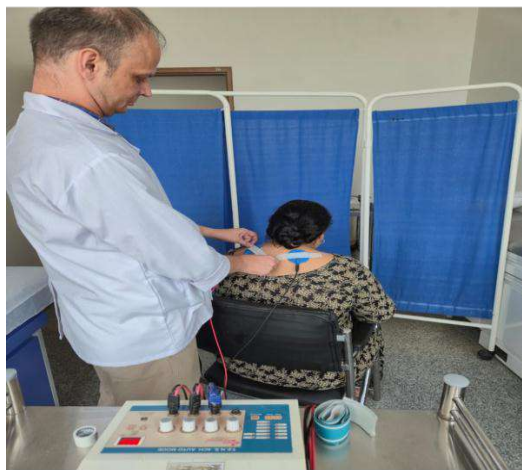

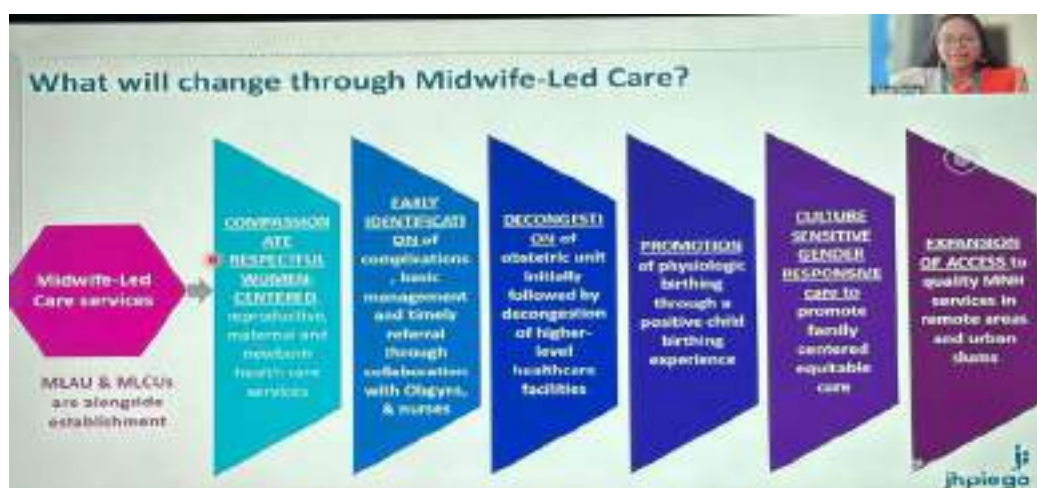
INTERNATIONAL DAY OF MIDWIVES
